

Advanced Placement Class Criteria



Why AP?

Confidence — Develop better study habits, improve your writing skills and sharpen your problem-solving abilities — this will give you the confidence to tackle the academic challenges that you can expect in college.

Credit — Entering college with AP credits gives you time to move into upper-level courses in your field of interest, pursue a double major, or study/travel abroad.

College Success — Research consistently shows that students who are successful in AP typically experience greater academic success in college than similar students who do not participate in AP.

REGINA HIGH SCHOOL AP CLASS REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ Minimum cumulative GPA: 3.14
- ✓ Overall “A” average during both semesters in the subject area of the prior school year
 - Typically, consideration for AP class placement is granted in similar subject pairings
(*example: Math and Science / English and Social Studies*)
- ✓ AP class cannot be dropped once started; there is not a mid-year replacement offered for full-year AP classes.
- ✓ Single-semester AP classes are weighted for .50 credit; Full-year AP classes are weighted for 1.0 credit
 - ½ credits will not be issued for full-year AP classes
